High Demand for Qualified Nurses

Germany is a highly developed country, the biggest economy in Europe and the fourth largest economy worldwide. Germany is ranked as one of the safest countries and its healthcare system is generally recognized as one of the best in the world. German healthcare institutions in general and nursing homes in particular are always on the lookout for professional nurses in order to meet the growing shortage of qualified nursing staff in this important sector of the German economy.

In view of the increasing shortage of qualified nurses in Germany, especially in the field geriatric care due to high life expectancy, the demand for foreign nurses is expected to rise steadily in the coming 10 years. There are currently over 40,000 available job positions in care facilities that are waiting to be filled. The German Nursing Council predicts that Germany will need up to 300,000 professional nurses until 2030.



Requirements for International Nurses

1. Nursing Qualification (Diploma or Bachelor certificate with transcript)
2. Licensure as a Registered Nurse (Sijil Lembaga Jururawat Malaysia)
3. Knowledge of the German language (at least at Level B1 of CEFR)
4. Recognition of Nursing Qualification by German authorities
5. Job offer / Employment Contract from the German employer
6. Visa and work permit to practise the nursing profession in Germany
